New California laws

- Fair Pay Act expanded to race and ethnicity
- Applicant's prior pay history cannot be used to justify wage differential
- Employers must give all new hires a notice of rights for domestic violence, sexual assault and stalking
- Employers prohibited from asking applicants about juvenile convictions and other information
- Passage of marijuana legalization should not change employment practices
- All single-user toilet facilities in a business must be identified by signage as all-gender
- Itemized wage statements for most salaried exempt employees not required to show total hours worked
- Employers prohibited from requesting more or different documents than required under federal law to work in the U.S.
- And more...

Other new developments

- US DOL proposed regulation raising salary for exempt employees on hold
- Other federal regulations and requirements (EEO-1?) in doubt given President-Elect
- And more...
